Book proposals

We publish monographs, revised theses, edited collections, excavation reports and conference proceedings. Information on how to submit your proposal/manuscript is shown below.

If your manuscript is already written/completed

Please send us the following:

1. Your manuscript sent as an e-mail attachment or via www.wetransfer.com as a Word or PDF file.
2. An abstract and table of contents for your proposed book.
3. Information on whether any revisions are planned and the timescale for completing the revisions.
4. An author CV, highlighting any past publications and indicating any current research projects that you are engaged in. If your manuscript is an edited collection, please provide biographical details about each contributor.
5. A word count (excluding tables).
6. Details of the number of black and white and/or colour illustrations used. Please state the type of illustration used e.g. a table, map, photo, graph etc.
7. Information on whether your book needs to be published by a certain date.

If your manuscript is a PhD thesis

We require the information above from points 2–7 (above) as well as:

1. Your complete thesis sent as an e-mail attachment or via www.wetransfer.com as a Word or PDF file.
2. Any examples of your existing published work.
3. A copy of your examiners' reports.
4. Information on who your supervisor was.

If your manuscript is not yet written

Please send us the following:

1. The table of contents.
2. A brief description of the book (150–300 words) including a summary of each chapter.
3. An estimation of the number of black and white and/or colour illustrations that will be used. Please state the type of illustrations that will be used e.g. tables, maps, photos, graphs etc.
4. The estimated final word count.
5. Your proposed timetable for submitting your manuscript and the suggested publication date.
6. An author CV, highlighting any past publications and indicating any current research projects that you are engaged in. If your manuscript is an edited collection, please provide biographical details about each contributor.

When submitting your proposal please could you let us know the following details:

- Has any part of your manuscript / thesis been published elsewhere?
- Is your manuscript / thesis currently available for download online in its present form or as a shorter version?
- If it is available online, could you please check the link and let us know:
 - i. The terms of this arrangement and if your manuscript / thesis could be removed from the site in question?
 - ii. How long your manuscript / thesis has been available online for?

Review process

Once we receive your proposal, we will aim to undertake the review process as quickly as possible. After an initial internal stage of consideration, we will inform you whether we will be sending your proposal to be peer reviewed.

Following the peer review process, if your manuscript/proposal is accepted we will offer you a contract. If your manuscript/proposal is not accepted, your manuscript and the information that you submitted will be destroyed/deleted after one month unless you request its return in writing.

Publication

The contract will outline the arranged delivery date, the agreed word count and the responsibilities of the Author and Publisher.

Production usually takes between 2–4 months. If a publication date has been agreed then the production schedule will reflect this.

Upon publication you will receive 10 complimentary copies of your book. Further copies are available at a 35% discount; please note that these copies are not for re-sale.

Marketing
